In his first season, he guided the team to the WCAC Conference tournament Semi-finals and a birth in the State Final for the first time in program history. In addition to being heavily involved in high school soccer, Leiva has been involved with Club soccer for several years where has been coaching in McLean. Known for taking a program and turning it around, Leiva has taken his U16 Boys team from obscurity to the Second Division of the NCSL.. During his years of coaching, Leiva has had over 40 former players move on to play at the collegiate level.

O'Hara's playing career is extensive where as a youth he represented the Republic of Ireland at the U-15 and U-18 level. He landed in the United States where he played for George Mason University.
